**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO ENFORCE
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

This Court previously issued a Temporary Restraining Order to extend the voter registration deadline to Wednesday, October 12, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. ECF No. 15, and later issued a Preliminary Injunction extending that deadline to Tuesday, October 18, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. ECF No. 29. At the initial hearings conducted by this Court, there was no discussion as to how long it would take for those newly registered voters to obtain active-voter status. Necessarily implied within this Court's orders was that those

who registered would actually have the ability to vote in the 2016 General Election.

Plaintiff filed an Emergency Motion to Enforce the Preliminary Injunction, specifically asking Defendant to provide an updated active-voter list, to complete verifying voter registration by October 23, 2016, and, if any voter registrations have not been processed by October 23, 2016, to submit an updated active-voter list on October 24, 2016. ECF No. 32. This Court held a hearing on that motion. ECF Nos. 35–36.

For the reasons stated on the record, the motion is **DE-**
NIED.
