Connecticut

Registration Deadline

Forms must be postmarked or delivered by a third party 14 days before, or received in person 7 days before, a general election.¹

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Database Implementation Status

Connecticut currently uses a top-down voter registration database, in which municipal officials have direct access to a centralized statewide database, built by PCC Technology Group.²

Entering Voter Registration Information

Who inputs voter registration information? Connecticut has no statewide policy reflected in statutes or regulations.³

What happens to voter registration forms submitted at state registration agencies? Connecticut has no statewide policy reflected in statutes or regulations.

How are most forms submitted? Connecticut reported that in 2004, 52% of forms were submitted by mail, 37% were submitted in person to election officials, 6% were submitted at the DMV, 3% were submitted at another voter registration agency, and 1% were submitted by other means.⁴

The relevant portions of the voter registration form are included at the end of this section.

Processing of Forms Without Identifying Numbers

How will the state treat an application with an affirmative indication that the applicant has no valid identifying number? Connecticut's form does not clearly state how an applicant should indicate that she has no valid identifying number.

How will the state treat an application without an identifying number and without an affirmative indication that the applicant has no such number? If the applicant is otherwise eligible, she will be considered registered, but will have to show identification at the polls.⁵

How will the state treat an application listing an identifying number that is either incomplete or illegible? Connecticut has no statewide policy reflected in statutes or regulations.

Matching Against Motor Vehicle and Social Security Records

What fields from the voter registration form will the state seek to match to motor vehicle or Social Security records? Identifying number, name, and date of birth.⁶

Description of matching process: Connecticut's matching process is not reflected in statutes or regulations.

What are the consequences if the state cannot find a match? If the applicant is otherwise eligible, she will apparently be considered registered, but will have to show identification at the polls.⁷

Notice and Opportunity to Resolve Errors

Description of notice and correction process: Connecticut's notice and correction process is not reflected in statutes or regulations.

Identification Requirements at the Polls

Who must provide identification at the polls? A first-time voter registering by mail whose identifying number has not been verified will be required to show identification at the polls.⁸

Forms of ID:

1st-time voters registering by mail without verified identifying number: current and valid photo ID current utility bill w/ name, address bank statement w/ name, address government check w/ name, address paycheck w/ name, address other gov't document w/ name, address

What forms of identification are accepted?

A current and valid photo ID, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows the voter's name and address.⁹

What are the consequences of failing to show identification? The voter may cast a provisional ballot.¹⁰ The ballot will be counted if the municipal registrar determines that the applicant is eligible to vote.¹¹

Statutes and Regulations

CONN. GEN. STAT. ch. 143 generally concerns registration. CONN. GEN. STAT. § 9-50b directs the Secretary of State to develop and administer a statewide voter registration database. Conn. Agencies Regs. §§ 9-32-1 *et seq.* comprise the applicable regulations.
