The BRIC identified threatening tweets toward LE and others on the morning of 12/7/21. The Twitter user was identified by the BRIC as [Redacted] with an address of [Redacted] and found to have ties to both Revere and Boston. The BRIC worked with Revere PD and C-11 units leading to TRINH's arrest by BPD C-11 units later in the day. It was revealed that earlier in the day, the individual assaulted a neighbor and had warrants as well as an active restraining order. The suspect was sent to Bridgewater for further evaluation and is due to appear in Dorchester Court.

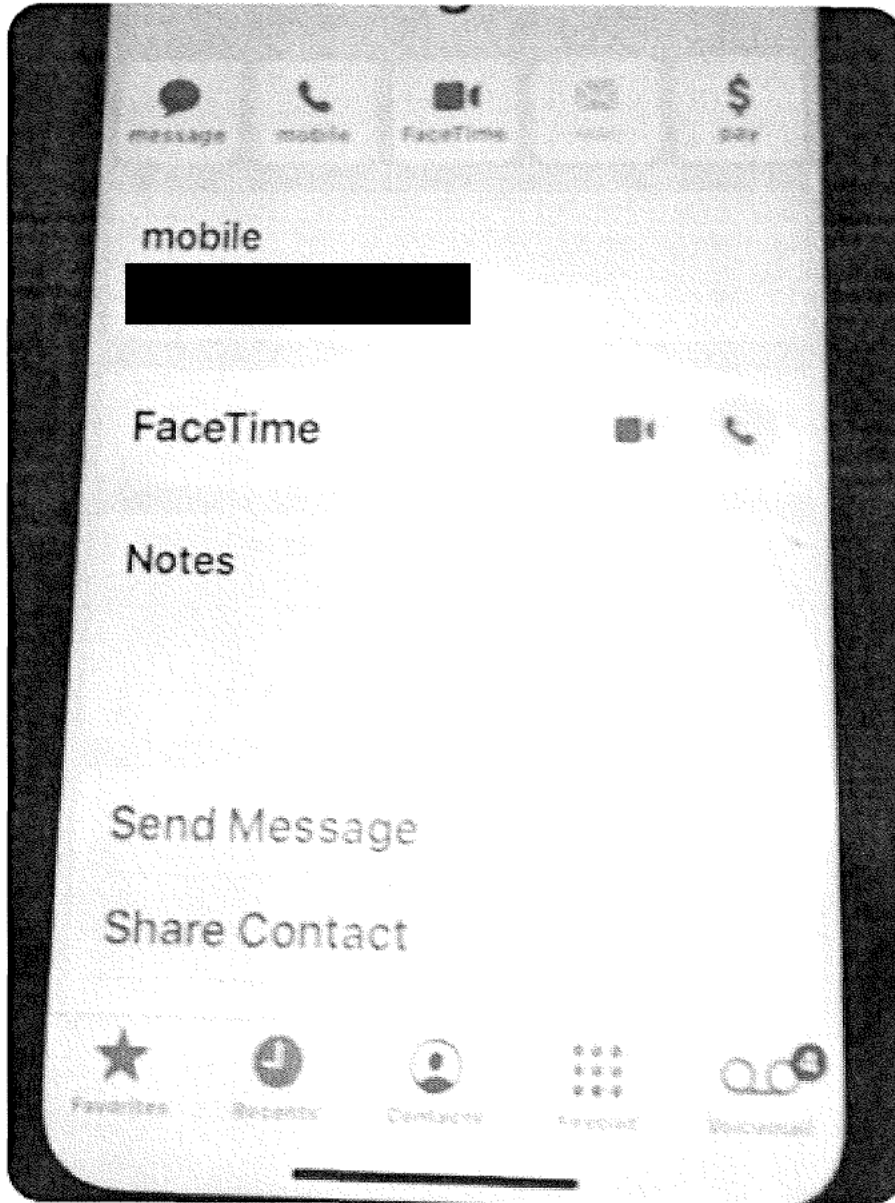

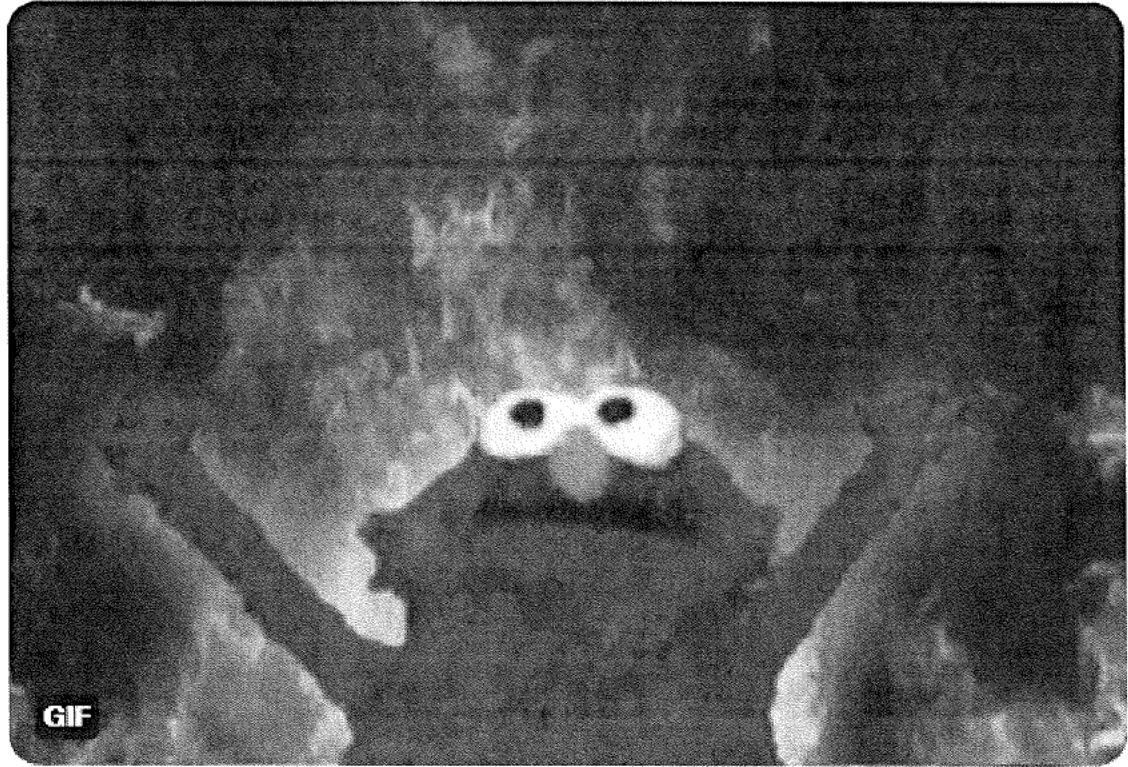

Per Sgt McLaughlin, you've been assigned to follow-up on the attached Telegram post that Evans came across on the Official Proud Boys New England Telegram channel.

On 22 December 2021 at 5:46 AM, Telegram user [REDACTED] made a veiled threat toward Boston Mayor Michele Wu. Screenshots of the threat are attached, but the text in question is below:

The only thing that'll work at this point is a 308 and a set of balls

Evans was able to link the above handle to [REDACTED] Looking at that address, the below father and son emerged as possible identities behind the [REDACTED] handle.



Note that [REDACTED] has an active LTC issued out of Billerica and at least one registered firearm.

[REDACTED] also has an active LTC, but no registered firearms.

Incident was entered into eGuardian a bit ago.

Det. Teixeira,

Per Sgt. Det. Meade, you have been assigned to follow up on the information below regarding a likely Boston based individual posting some pretty strong rhetoric online about yesterday's events. This will also be going into eGuardian.

On November 8 at 9:54 AM twitter account [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] tweeted the following:

"IF THE BOSTON POLICE DONT PROTECT ITS CITIZENS, WE MUST BRING LARGE WEAPONS AT ALL OUR RALLIES AND PROTECT OURSELVES!!"

Please find a screenshot of the tweet attached below as well as links to original tweet and the archived version.

Further examination of this account revealed the following additional tweets

At 8:54 AM on November 8 this account tweeted "IF THIS CONTINUES WE PATRIOTIC AMERICANS MUST ALLY WITH RUSSIA, GET THE WMDS WE NEED AND PURGE OUR GOD BLESSED HOMELAND!!!!" Screenshot attached as well as original and archived versions.

At 9:03 AM on November 8 this account tweeted "ITS TIME FOR " MASS REVOLUTION " ACROSS OUR " GOD BLESSED HOMELAND " IMMEDIATELY!!!!" Screenshot attached as well as links to original and archived versions.

At 9:19AM on November 8 this account tweeted "ITS TIME TO WAGE WAR!!!" Screenshot attached as well as links to the original and archived versions.

It is my assessment based on open source information that it is possible that the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who appears to be a real person, a retired Lt from the Boston Fire Department and is associated with an address in South Boston, may also be the same [REDACTED] associated with the twitter account which shared the tweets detailed above this morning.

Research located a Facebook page for a "[REDACTED]" in boston posting similar rhetoric to that on the twitter account detailed above. Older posts do appear to show that the individual behind this account has engaged with family and friends on the platform. The account has posted pictures of grandchildren and interacted with other accounts. This may indicate that it is not simply a fake or troll account. Additionally, this facebook account has also shared firefighter related content in the past and engaged with local "America Backs the Blue" content.

A LinkedIn page was also identified which stated that [REDACTED] was or is currently a

Lieutenant with the Boston Fire Department, screenshot attached.

A document containing General Orders for the Boston Fire Department in 2003 was located on the Boston Fire Historical Society Website which stated that a [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] retired. The order goes on to state that [REDACTED] was appointed to the department on [REDACTED] and promoted to Fire Lieutenant on [REDACTED]. The link can be found here and the pdf is attached.

A document search with the Suffolk County Registrar of Deeds revealed that a [REDACTED] is associated with the address [REDACTED]. Screenshots attached.

No phone number or email address has yet been identified.

On 11-27-2021, Detectives Teixeira and Blocker responded to [REDACTED] and attempted to contact [REDACTED] but there was no response at the door.

On 12-01-2021, Detectives [REDACTED] responded to 1 [REDACTED] and attempted to contact [REDACTED] but there was no response at the door.

Dec 04 2021 - Follow-Up Report# 4

Entry Case Follow-Up Report# 4 Inv Person [REDACTED]

On 12-04-2021, Detective Teixeira called [REDACTED] and left a message on his voicemail. [REDACTED] called the BRIC main number a few minutes later and asked to speak to Detective Teixeira. Detective Teixeira and [REDACTED] discussed the Twitter postings that [REDACTED] posted a few weeks ago. Detective Teixeira asked Mr. [REDACTED] if he was the person who posted the comments on Twitter about the Boston Commons protest in early November

and he stated he did. [REDACTED] continued to say that the Twitter post were not threatening to anybody and he was exercising his right to free speech. [REDACTED] stated that he was being harassed by Detective Teixeira because he felt that he did not do anything wrong by posting the statements on Twitter. Detective Teixeira explained to [REDACTED] that he was just doing his job and contacting him as a follow-up to clarify his intentions. Detective Teixeira explained to [REDACTED] that he was not trying cause any problems for him and did not call to make any demands or get him upset. Detective Teixeira informed [REDACTED] that he merely wanted to contact him and have a conversation respectfully. Once [REDACTED] felt comfortable speaking with Detective Teixeira, he seemed to relax and open up and became more forthcoming.

[REDACTED] stated he did not attend the protest rally at the Boston Commons but spoke to some of his friends who did attend the protest. [REDACTED] stated he posted the comments on Twitter because he was upset that the Boston police did not properly protect the protesters who had lawfully obtained a permit to peacefully protest on that day at the Boston Commons and were abandoned by the Boston Police who did not do their job and allowed the Antifa counter protesters to attack the peaceful protesters. He stated the Antifa counter protesters did not have a permit to be there. [REDACTED] stated that he supports the Boston Police in general and has no ill will towards the police. He stated that his post did not threaten anybody and he has no intention on causing any violence with his post. He was frustrated with how the event turned out and felt that the peaceful protesters have a right to at least defend themselves if they are attacked again. He stated he tries to be very careful with what he says on social media and does not promote any violence.

[REDACTED] stated he is a veteran and served his country honorably and loves his country. He stated he is a retired Lieutenant from the Boston Fire Department and has lived in South Boston his entire life. He stated he has never been physically violent and never will be. He stated his son is a Boston Police Officer and his other son served in the military and was a war hero in the Iraq war. He said he will never post any threats on social media and will never promote any violence. He informed Detective that he does not have to worry about him starting trouble as a 72 year old Grandfather. He stated he does not have a gun permit and does not own any guns.

[REDACTED] stated he was visited at his house in July by U.S. Marshalls for prior post he made about a judge. He stated after a very brief conversation outside of his house, the U.S. Marshalls ended up leaving from the front of his house after agreeing that the post were not threatening. He further stated that he was recently kicked off Facebook because of his criticizing House Speaker Nancy Pelosi's policies.

[REDACTED] continued to speak about his love for his country and all citizens of the United States. He stated he speaks out only to prevent the United States from becoming a "Communist" country. He instructed detective Teixeira that he does not have to call him lieutenant and insisted Detective Teixeira called him [REDACTED]. The conversation ended in friendly chatter.

Investigation / Threatening Twitter posts regarding Boston Common rally / No report

Lt,

This case was assigned after several Twitter posts were made by [REDACTED] regarding the First Amendment rally on the Boston Common on November 7th. Although the posts were not directed at any specific individual, they contained language that appeared to be calling for

violence. The posts included such language as "WE MUST BRING LARGE WEAPONS AT ALL OUR RALLIES AND PROTECT OURSELVES", "GET THE WMDS AND PURGE OUR GOD BLESSED HOMELAND!!!", "ITS TIME FOR A MASS REVOLUTION" AND "ITS TIME TO WAGE WAR".

Det. Teixeira was assigned to contact the account holder [REDACTED] a 72 year old South Boston resident to ascertain the intention of his comments as they pertained to future violence at rally's. After several visits to [REDACTED] home in South Boston, Det. Teixeira was finally able to speak to him by phone. During the conversation, [REDACTED] stated that he was very careful not to threaten anyone in his posts. He stated that although he did not attend the rally on the Common, he was very upset with the reports of the Boston Police allowing the First Amendment protesters to be attacked by Antifa. He stated that the First Amendment crowd had done everything right by getting a permit to have their event. The Antifa side had not done the same.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he supports the Boston Police in general and has no ill will towards the police. He stated that his post did not threaten anybody and he has no intention of causing any violence with his post. He was frustrated with how the event turned out and felt that the peaceful protesters have a right to at least defend themselves if they are attacked again. He stated he tries to be very careful with what he says on social media and does not promote any violence.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated he is a veteran and served his country honorably and loves his country. He stated he is a retired Lieutenant from the Boston Fire Department and has lived in South Boston his entire life. He stated he has never been physically violent and never will be. He stated his son is a Boston Police Officer and his other son served in the military and was a war hero in the Iraq war. He said he will never post any threats on social media and will never promote any violence. He informed Detective Teixeira that he does not have to worry about him starting trouble as a 72 year old Grandfather. He stated he does not have a gun permit and does not own any guns. This information was verified through a CJIS check.

Based on the interview with [REDACTED] it is my opinion that he is very passionate about his feelings about the country and the direction that he sees it going. Although the posts certainly could be interpreted as promoting violence at future rallies, it appears to be more rhetoric than reality. [REDACTED] has been put on notice that he needs to be very careful about what he writes on social media in the future. As a result, I am requesting that this case be considered CLOSED pending any additional information that the words written are being put into action at future events.

Nov 08 2018 - Initial intake

This report is authored by Detective Aaron T. Blocker assigned to the Boston Regional Intelligence Center. The following report is based upon information received and observations made. The statements made, dates and times are not intended to be verbatim but are approximate.

On November 6, 2018 I was assigned by Lt. Detective Fitzpatrick to follow up on a Twitter threat post by person(s) unknown who utilizes the Twitter account [REDACTED]

On or about November 6, 2018 [REDACTED] posted on their Twitter account "Hey Jeff Jacoby who writes for the Boston Globe
I'll kill your entire family"

On November 7, 2018 I along with Detective John Teixeira went to [REDACTED] in an attempt to locate and identify the sender of a threatening email addressed to Boston Globe reporter Jeff Jacoby. This address is associated to a post on the Twitter account utilized by [REDACTED]

BRIC Analyst Jennifer Seeley who located the open source threat on Twitter conducted a workup of the Twitter Account to try and identify the user with negative results.

Analyst Seeley, however was able to locate several Twitter profile screenshots of an unknown white transgender male who utilizes social media site (mastodon) that appears to be associated with [REDACTED]

Detectives on arrival to [REDACTED] met with the bank's Assistant Manager Jennifer Christie.

Detectives after announcing our office and purpose showed Ms. Christie several photos of the unknown transgender white male that were obtained from the social media site (mastodon).

Ms. Christie could not identify the person in the pictures that were shown to her.

Ms. Christie informed Detectives that she has been employed with Rockland Trust Bank for over 13 years, and was assigned to this Branch (Brighton) when it opened in February of 2015, and doesn't remember the person in the photos ever working for the bank.

Ms. Christie stated that the person did resemble a customer that frequents the bank but could

not be absolutely sure.

Ms. Christie informed Detectives that the Branch Manager [REDACTED] could be back to work on 11/08/18, and requested a copy of the pictures to show her. I provide Ms. Christie with a copy of the photos of the unknown white male transgender.

This matter to be further investigated.

Nov 08 2018 - Follow-Up

On November 8, 2018 I submitted a Law Enforcement Emergency Request by email to Twitter requesting a name, date of birth, physical address or postal address, and phone number for the person(s) utilizing the Twitter Account [REDACTED]. Supervisory Homeland Security Analyst Mark Bachtta provided me with the Twitter URL address of [REDACTED].

This matter to be further investigated.

Nov 13 2018 - Follow-Up

On November 08, 2018 Detective John Teixeira spoke with Rockland Trust Branch Manager [REDACTED] regarding the suspect who made threats on Twitter.

[REDACTED] stated that after reviewing the photos of the person left by Detectives that she was not able to identify him.

[REDACTED] further stated that the person in the photos did not work for the Rockland Trust Brighton MA., Branch and that she doesn't recognize him from being a customer.

This matter to be further investigated.

Dec 11 2018 - Follow-Up

On December 11, 2018 Detectives met with Supervisory AD Megan O'Rourke assigned to the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office to obtain an Administrative Subpoena for the Twitter Account [REDACTED].

Detectives were informed by ADA O'Rourke that Twitter will not accept an Administrative Subpoena for subscriber information, nor a personal phone call, stating that a search warrant would need to be served.

It was learned that the MSP Fusion Center has the capability to conduct facial recognition of photographs.

On December 11, 2018 BRIC Senior Supervisory Analyst Mark Bachtta forwarded to the Massachusetts State Police Fusion Center several photographs of an individual that were posted on the Twitter Account [REDACTED]. Supervisory Analyst Bachtta informed me that upon review of the photographs no further information could be provided.

To be further investigated.

Dec 14 2018 -

On December 14, 2018 Detective submitted to Twitter.com a second Emergency Disclosure Request for Twitter Account # [REDACTED]

This matter is currently under further investigation.

Jan 09 2019 - Follow-Up

On January 9, 2019 BPD Detective Carla Sullivan assigned to the Bureau of Investigative Services who is assisting the BRIC in this ongoing investigation sent an Evidence Preservation letter to Twitter for account [REDACTED]. This is also in anticipation of obtaining an administrative subpoena from the Suffolk County District Attorney's office for non-disclosure information for the Twitter Account [REDACTED].

This matter to be further investigated.

Feb 06 2019 - Follow-Up

Detective Sullivan spoke to DA Granda by email regarding the Administrative Subpoena for the non-disclosure request on or about January 25, 2019. DA Granada stated that because of the rules governing non-disclosure orders, they require more than just not wanting to inform the victim, and at this point into the investigation she felt that if the suspect is informed it might be ok at this stage.

Detective Sullivan states that she emailed DA Granda and showed her a threat to a Laura Etter from [REDACTED] and that they may be utilizing 2 profiles. Detective Sullivan further informed DA Granda that a person who may be disturbed may be triggered if they were made aware that Law Enforcement was involved.

To be further investigated.

Feb 08 2019 - Follow-Up

On February 8, 2019 I received an email from Detective Carla Sullivan who is assigned to the BPD Forensic Group who is assisting me with the Twitter threat investigation.

Detective Sullivan informed me thru email that the Suffolk County District Attorney's office responded that they are waiting for the returns to the subpoenas.

This matter to be further investigated.

Feb 25 2019 - Follow-Up

On February 25, 2019 I along with Detective Teixeira responded to the Shaw's Supermarket at 1065 Commonwealth Avenue to meet with Laura Etter the Customer Service Manager for this store.

Detectives had received information from BPD Detective Carla Sullivan that Ms. Etter was the subject of a post on Twitter from a person utilizing the Twitter Account [REDACTED] that stated "kill Laura Etter"

Detectives showed Ms. Etter several photographs that were obtained from a publicly available social media site who we believed to be the person utilizing the Twitter Account [REDACTED]

Ms. Etter identified the person in the photographs as a [REDACTED] who is currently employed at the Shaw's Supermarket as a Customer Service Representative.

Ms. Etter stated to Detectives that back in November of 2018, she had spoken to suspect [REDACTED] several times that day about not drinking water while working on the sales floor. She stated that this upset suspect [REDACTED] who then pushed a carriage across the floor and left the store stating "I'm out of here". It was later learned that suspect [REDACTED] was allowed to return back to work after a few days.

Ms. Etter stated that she has not had any confrontations with suspect [REDACTED] since that day in November 2018. She further stated to Detectives that she has had several conversations since with him, but they have been pleasant.

Ms. Etter stated that she would not be looking to press any charges for threats against suspect [REDACTED] at this time.

Detectives were informed that suspect [REDACTED] was scheduled to be off until the morning of February 28, 2019.

Detectives were provided a contact number, dob and address for suspect [REDACTED] that were entered into several BRIC databases by RTCC Analyst Joe Madden.

Also present at Shaw's Supermarket was the Mr. Stepan Petrosyan the Store Director, and Thomas Carnazzo, the store Security Director.

This matter to be further investigated.

Feb 28 2019 - Follow-Up

On February 28, 2019 at approximately 11:40 PM I along with Detective John Teixeira went to the Shaw's Supermarket located at 1065 Commonwealth Avenue, Boston in an attempt to interview suspect [REDACTED]

Detectives upon arrival notified our Boston Police Operations. Detectives were greeted by the store Director Stepan Petrosyan who alerted suspect [REDACTED] that we were present, and that we were interested in speaking with him.

Detectives introduced themselves to suspect [REDACTED] with their badges clearly displayed announcing their office and purpose. Detectives asked suspect [REDACTED] if he would be willing to speak with us when he responded "yes".

Detectives explained to suspect [REDACTED] that he wasn't under arrest and that we wanted to discuss with him an ongoing investigation of something he may have posted on his Twitter Page.

Detectives voluntarily escorted suspect [REDACTED] to a conference room at the supermarket that

was provided for by the store Director.

Detective asked suspect [REDACTED] his name, current address and age which he provided. Detectives asked him if he has a Twitter Account when he stated "yes". He was asked if he had any other social media accounts when he responded "several". Detectives asked him within the past 4 months if he utilized the Twitter Account [REDACTED] and went by the name of [REDACTED] when he stated "yes".

I asked suspect [REDACTED] to specifically thing back to the 2018 November Elections, asking if he remembers posting a comment on his Twitter page about Jeff Jacoby a Globe columnist, when he replied that "he didn't remember".

I asked suspect [REDACTED] if he remembers posting a comment on his Twitter page about Jeff Jacoby who published an article in the Globe about Transgender Rights and why you should vote "NO", when he stated, not really what did I do dumb?".

Suspect [REDACTED] admitted to Detectives that he posts a lot of things and that he does get upset sometimes becoming emotional.

I showed suspect [REDACTED] several photographs of a individual who posted pictures of themselves on the Twitter page [REDACTED] and showed them to suspect MAZZALO to review. After looking at these photographs I asked him if these are pictures of himself when replied "yes". I then showed him several other pictures of a home that were posted on this same Twitter page asking him if he posted these when he replied "yes". I then asked if he lives here now when he replied "yes".

I then showed suspect [REDACTED] a post from his Twitter Account [REDACTED] where he posted on his page "Hey Jeff Jacoby who writes for the Boston Globe I'll kill your entire family" asking him if he posted the comment when he replied "yes".

Detectives asked suspect [REDACTED] if it is his intent to cause any harm to Jeff Jacoby or his family when he replied "no". He was asked if he has any access to firearms or if he has a License to Carry a Firearm, when he stated "no".

Detectives asked suspect [REDACTED] if he is currently taking prescription medication and under the care of a physician, when he responded "I used to, but I am no longer". I asked him if he has been treated for mental health issues in the past when he responded "yes, approximately 2 years ago", stating that " he was being treated by a therapist at the Fenway Health Center.

Detectives advised suspect [REDACTED] that this is an active and ongoing investigation, and demanded that he delete the Twitter post threatening Jeff Jacoby and his family.

Suspect [REDACTED] informed Detectives that he no longer has access to his Twitter Account [REDACTED]

This matter to be further investigated.

Mar 01 2019 - Follow-Up

On February 28, 2019 at approximately 5:40 PM I along with Detective Teixeira responded to the Boston Globe located at Exchange Place, Boston to interview Globe Columnist Jeff Jacoby. Mr. Jacoby is identified as the victim of threats posted by [REDACTED] on his Twitter page [REDACTED] November 2018.

Detectives upon arriving made contact with a security guard working for Exchange Place. After identifying ourselves and announcing our office and purpose, we were informed by security that after speaking with Boston Globe personnel he was told that Jeff Jacoby was unavailable.

Detectives left a business card with their contact information with him to be forwarded to Mr. Jacoby.

This matter to be further investigated.

Mar 06 2019 - Follow-Up

Pending any further developments or information received I'm requesting this case be closed.

Mar 13 2019 - Follow-Up

On March 5, 2019 at approximately 4:15 PM BRIC Detective Blocker and Teixeira spoke with Boston Globe Columnist Jeff Jacoby from his contact number [REDACTED]

Detective Blocker after announcing our office and purpose for the call, informed Mr. Jacoby about the threats directed at him and his family from suspect [REDACTED] that he posted on his Twitter Account.

Detectives informed Mr. Jacoby that suspect [REDACTED] had been identified and interviewed, admitting that he posted the threats. Mr. Jacoby was informed that suspect [REDACTED] stated that he had no intentions to harm him or his family.

Mr. Jacoby informed Detectives that he has been employed with the Boston Globe for over 25 years and has received numerous threats in the past that he hadn't reported. Mr. Jacoby stated that he did not wish to pursue complaints against [REDACTED], stating that he would take any future threats more seriously, and notify the proper authorities to have it documented.
