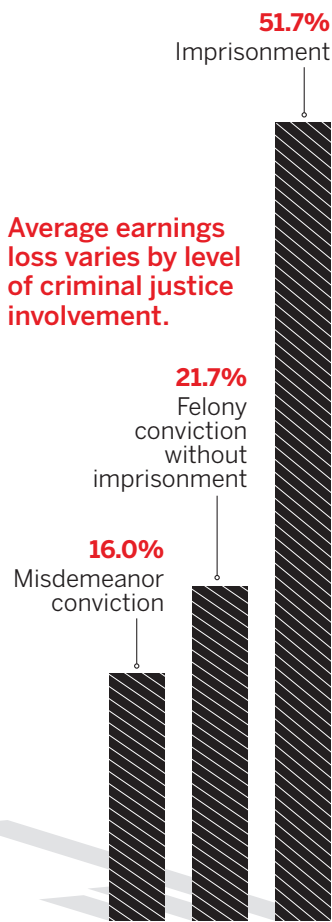


Black people with no criminal record earn less than socioeconomically similar white people with a record.

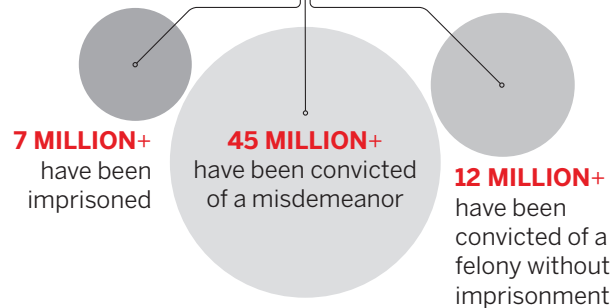

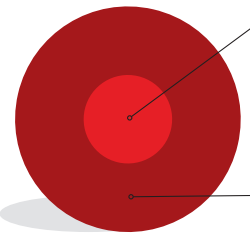
AMERICANS WHO HAVE A CRIMINAL RECORD OF SOME KIND
