Re: California Public Records Request

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a request under the California Public Records Act (“PRA”)¹ on behalf of the Brennan Center for Justice at NYU School of Law.

Background

The Brennan Center seeks records pertaining to a new program aimed at “countering violent extremism” (CVE). On April 15, 2014, a senior White House official announced a CVE envoy program designed to “coordinat[e] government engagement on the threat of homegrown violent extremism.”² And on September 15, 2014, Attorney General Eric Holder announced the creation of a CVE “pilot” program to begin in three cities,³ one of which is Los Angeles.⁴

The Brennan Center is requesting information on the rules governing the involvement of the Los Angeles Police Department in these CVE programs.

Request

The Brennan Center specifically requests the following records under the PRA:

1. All policies, procedures, and directives referencing the Los Angeles Police Department's participation in CVE programs, including:
 - a. Documents referring to the envoy program.⁵
 - b. Documents referring to the pilot programs announced by Attorney General Eric Holder in his September 2014 press release.⁶
 - c. Any other documents referring to CVE programs in Los Angeles.

2. All Memorandums of Understanding with outside agencies applicable to the Los Angeles Police Department's participation in CVE programs, including:
 - a. Documents referring to the envoy program.⁷
 - b. Documents referring to the pilot programs announced by Attorney General Eric Holder in his September 2014 press release.⁸
 - c. Documents referring to CVE programs in:
 - i. Minneapolis
 - ii. Saint Paul
 - iii. Los Angeles
 - iv. Boston

Response Within Ten Business Days

Consistent with the PRA, we ask that you make a determination within 10 days of receiving this request of the records in your possession that are responsive to the request and also determine whether the documents are subject to disclosure.⁹ Please promptly notify us of the determination and the reasons thereof.¹⁰ To the extent that your department chooses to withhold any record, please list, in writing, each and every document that is withheld as well as the reasons for doing so.¹¹ For those documents subject to disclosure, please provide an approximate date of delivery.¹² Should a part of any document contain information that is exempt from disclosure, please segregate and
