Thanks [REDACTED] I also received this feedback from the ISS regarding TLO and the usage of Social Media, Vehicle Sighting Reports, Real Time Phone Carrier Search, or Super Reverse Phones

“From what I understand, they mostly use TLO for phone number and address searches but that’s it. They run social media searches in TLO but I believe its more cumbersome than Accurint and the results vary. The vehicle sighting report function is used sporadically at best.

I know I have never used the Real-time phone carrier or super reverse phones tools and neither has Ebony or Lauren.

Generally, now that the team has Accurint, TLO is used more of a backup rather than a primary.”

That seems to line up with the overall trend of the TLO usage.
