### CLEAR\* SERVICES TEMPORARY ACCESS AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT entered into between District of Columbia Metropolitan Police Department ("Licensee") and West, a Thomson Reuters business ("West") regarding certain West research services, as follows:

#### License.

- a. CLEAR Services. "Data" means all information and representations of information, including, but not limited to, graphical representations, and other content made available to Licensee through the CLEAR Services. Licensee may: (i) display Data internally; (ii) quote and excerpt from Data (appropriately cited and credited) by electronic cutting and pasting or other means in memoranda, briefs, reports, and similar work product created by Licensee in the regular course of Licensee's research and work; and (iii) to the extent not expressly prohibited by the terms of the Agreement, use Data as permitted under the fair use provision of the Copyright Act (17 U.S.C.A. § 107). Downloaded information shall not be stored or used in an archival database or other searchable database except as expressly permitted by this Agreement.

### 2. License Restrictions.

- a. Usage Restrictions. Licensee may not copy, download, scrape, store, publish, post, transmit, retransmit, transfer, distribute, disseminate, broadcast, circulate, sell, resell, or otherwise use the Data, or any portion of the Data, in any form or by any means except as expressly permitted by paragraph 1 (License Grant) above, or as otherwise expressly permitted in writing by West. Licensee shall not reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise attempt to discern the source code of the Products, their components, or any avenue by which Products are accessed.
- b. Compliance with Applicable Law. Licensee shall not use any Data and shall not distribute any Data to a third party for use in a manner contrary to or in violation of any applicable federal, state, or local law, rule or regulation.

By accessing Data, Licensee acknowledges that from time to time, West and its Contributors and/or various government entities will require Licensee to identify a permissible use (if applicable) and may inquire as to Licensee's compliance with applicable laws or the Agreement. 

























#### MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT

- 1. Parties. This Master Services Agreement (this "Master Agreement") is entered into by Customer (as defined in the Statement of Work ("SOW") that this Master Services Agreement governs) and Dataminr, Inc. ("Dataminr"). Customer must execute at least one SOW to purchase access to Dataminr services (individually and collectively, "Services"). To purchase additional Services, Customer must execute an additional SOW (which will be numbered sequentially, e.g., "SOW 1", SOW 2", and so on) that references this Agreement and sets forth the specific Services to be provided to Customer. An "Affiliate" of Customer is an entity that is controlled, controlled by, or is under common control with Customer.
- b. Dataminr will make the Services purchased by Customer available to Customer in accordance with this Agreement. Customer's Authorized Users (as defined below) may access and use the Services solely for Customer's internal purposes. The Third Party Terms may be modified from time to time by Dataminr and/or its third party licensors and data vendors at any time in their sole discretion by posting new terms at the Third Party Terms Site. These Third Party Terms are hereby incorporated into this Agreement. Customer is responsible for checking the Third Party Terms Site for updates, and any use by Customer of the Services following a change to the Third Party Terms shall constitute acceptance of such change. If Customer does not agree to the amended Third Party Terms, Customer must stop accessing and using the Services. Receiving Party shall advise Disclosing Party immediately in the event Receiving Party learns or has reason to believe that any person who has had access to Confidential Information has violated or intends to violate the terms of this Agreement and each Party will cooperate with the other Party in seeking injunctive or other equitable relief against any such person. Each Party acknowledges that in the event of any breach or threatened breach of this Section by either Party, the other Party may suffer irreparable harm and not possess an adequate remedy at law. Accordingly, each Party shall have the right to seek injunctive or other equitable relief to restrain such breach or threatened breach.

- c. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, nothing in this Agreement restricts Dataminr from using for analytics, research, product development, marketing and other business purposes any information about Customer's usage of the Services and the Customer Content on an aggregated and deidentified basis (the "Aggregated Data"); provided that, such information cannot reasonably be used to identify Customer and Dataminr does not publicly disclose any of the Customer Content in violation of this Section 11. - a. As between the Parties, Dataminr owns all right, title and interest to (a) Dataminr's trademarks, trade names, service marks, logos and slogans (collectively, the "Dataminr Marks") and (b) the Services, including all documentation, algorithms, software, firmware, data, databases or other technology utilized, and all related intellectual property rights in any of the foregoing. This Agreement does not confer on Customer any intellectual property or other rights to the Services other than its right to use under Section 3 and does not confer on Customer any rights to the Dataminr Marks.

I'm doing a quick check to make sure we have consistency of law enforcement information with MPDC and maybe others – before we have our DIR briefings.

PID didn't report any indicators of Antifa support in the crowds (tactics, logos, flags....)

I don't remember seeing anything from WFO JTTF either.

However, USSS/CSD reported that MPDC advised they were able to confirm that a portion of the protestors were "known Antifa members" utilizing "homemade shields made from cutting plastic drums in half, hard hats and umbrellas to provide concealment for other members who were throwing objects at police. The protesters also used rope stretched across the street in an attempt to trip officers." This caption accompanied the below image...



At this time, USSS doesn't have any information indicating our folks witnessed Antifa support in the crowds. Does WFO JTTF agree with this? Did your FBI folks generate anything to contradict this?

From 06/08/20 through 06/20/20, at 6:00PM, 846 Vigil and Protest for Black Lives Washington, DC (NRID) will host a demonstration called, "6:00PM Silent Vigil & Protest Take A Knee 8 Minutes & 46 Seconds". The purpose of the event is "to commit together as a multi-racial neighborhood to make dramatic change for the black community." Participant numbers are unknown at this time. No civil disobedience is expected. No known permit has been issued for this event.
