The Minnesota Legislature is considering a change in the way that judges are selected in Minnesota. The proposal they are considering includes three parts.

Under the first part of the proposal, a panel of both lawyers and non-lawyers, called the Merit Selection Committee, would evaluate and recommend potential judges to the Governor. The Governor would then choose a nominee from the list and appoint that individual to serve as a judge.

A second part of the proposal concerns "retention elections." At the end of the judge's term, the public would vote on whether a judge should retain the seat or be removed from office. No opponent would be listed on the ballot for this seat, and if the judge is retained by a majority of voters, he or she would keep their position for another term. But if the judge were rejected by voters, the selection process begins again.
