**JOINT STIPULATION OF
DISMISSAL**

By and through their attorneys, Plaintiffs, LEAGUE OF UNITED LATIN
AMERICAN CITIZENS OF UTAH, THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF UTAH,
CHERONNE ANDERSON, and LAVINIA TAUMOEPEAU-LATU, and Defendant,

SPENCER COX, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Utah (collectively “the Parties”), do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. On May 16, 2017, President Donald Trump signed Executive Order No. 13,799, which established the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity (the “Commission”).

2. On June 28, 2017, the Commission sent a letter to Lieutenant Governor Spencer Cox seeking certain information regarding Utah voters and elections.

3. On July 26, 2017, Plaintiffs initiated this lawsuit seeking, inter alia, to enjoin Defendants from complying with the terms of their request, and other relief.

4. On January 3, 2018, President Trump issued an Executive Order revoking Executive Order 13,799 and terminating the Commission. Executive Order of Jan. 3, 2018.¹

5. Upon issuance of the Executive Order, President Trump requested that the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) review the Commission’s “initial findings and determine next courses of action.” *See* Statement by the Press Sec. on the Commission (Jan. 3, 2018).²

6. In light of the disbanding of the Commission, Plaintiffs no longer request relief regarding the Commission’s request and the parties seek dismissal without prejudice.

7. If the federal government, on or before January 20, 2021, creates a new and similar Commission to the one that was recently dissolved, and that new Commission

makes a similar request to Lieutenant Governor's Office for a copy of the Voter Registration Database, the Lieutenant Governor's Office will notify counsel for the Plaintiffs prior to responding to the request.

8. Based upon the foregoing this case shall be dismissed in its entirety, without prejudice, pursuant to Rule 41, Utah Rules of Civil Procedure.

9. Each party will bear its own costs and attorneys' fees.
