PLAINTIFFS' POSITION ON THE SPECIAL MASTER'S RECOMMENDED PLAN

The Special Master's Recommended Plan is an appropriate and legal remedy to the extensive constitutional violations this Court found in the 2011 state legislative redistricting plans and the continuing constitutional defects in the 2017 Enacted Plans. This Court can and should order it into effect for the 2018 elections. The Special Master's Recommended Plan follows this Court's detailed instructions and affords appropriate deference to state policy. Plaintiffs have no objections to the Recommended Plan.¹

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¹ Plaintiffs reiterate their position, *see* Plaintiffs' Objections to the Defendants' Remedial Districts, at 42-43, ECF No. 189 (Sept. 15, 2017), that both the 2017 House and Senate plans enacted by the General Assembly are unconstitutional partisan gerrymanders. However, because this Court does not have the record before it to decide those objections, Plaintiffs reserve their right to assert those claims in separate litigation. Accordingly, because the Special Master's task was limited to only correcting the few racial gerrymandering and state constitutional defects in the 2017 Enacted Plan, he could not have corrected the gross partisan gerrymandering. Plaintiffs continue to respectfully request that this Court to make clear that whatever disposition it makes with respect to the ultimate remedial plan does not constitute, or imply, that these maps are not partisan gerrymanders or foreclose any future challenges to the 2017 plans on those grounds.
