SCHEDULING ORDER

BEFORE: Jordan, Circuit Judge; Kane, District Judge; Baylson, District Judge:

AND NOW this 11th day of January, 2018, following a Rule 16 conference this date, the Court **ORDERS** as follows:

1. With regard to the Motion to Dismiss (ECF 68) and the Motion to Stay or Abstain (ECF 69), responsive briefs, if any, shall be filed on or before January 18, 2018, and reply briefs may be filed within five (5) days thereafter.
2. With regard to the issue of accessibility of documents produced in Agre, et al. v. Wolf, et al., EDPA Civil Action 17-4392, Plaintiffs shall file an appropriate motion on or before January 19, 2018, and Defendants shall respond within one week thereafter, and a reply brief may be filed within five (5) days after that. The parties shall specify, to the extent appropriate, the documents that were produced in the Agre matter but not introduced into the trial record, that should be discoverable in this case.

3. The parties shall discuss the issue of collateral estoppel and in the absence of an agreement, an appropriate motion should be filed on or before January 25, 2018, with responses due within one week, and a reply brief may be filed within one week after that.

4. Briefs shall be limited to fifteen (15) pages, double-spaced, and be filed by 4:00 p.m. on the due date.

5. All motions shall be accompanied by a certificate of concurrence or non-concurrence.

6. Prior subpoenas for documents are quashed and discovery is stayed pending further Order of the Court.
