Smith, and Marc Veasey hereby appeal to the Supreme Court of the United States from these orders of the three-judge district court: the Order Granting Motion to Dismiss dated September 2, 2011 (ECF No. 285) and the Order on Plan C235 dated August 15, 2017 (ECF No. 1535).

Notice is also hereby given that Plaintiffs League of United Latin American Citizens (“LULAC”), Gabriel Rosales, Belen Robles, Ray Velarde, Johnny Villastrigo, Bertha Urteaga, Baldomero Garza, Marcelo H. Tafoya, Raul Villaronga, Asenet T. Armadillo, Elvira Rios, and Patricia Mancha hereby appeal to the Supreme Court of the United States from the Order on Plan C235 dated August 15, 2017 (ECF No. 1535).

On September 12, 2017, the Supreme Court granted Defendants’ motion for a stay pending the timely filing and disposition of an appeal.

This appeal is therefore taken pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1253 & 2284, which authorize direct appeals to the Supreme Court of the United States from a three-judge district court’s

interlocutory or permanent injunctive orders in an action challenging the constitutionality of the apportionment of congressional districts or the apportionment of any statewide legislative body.
