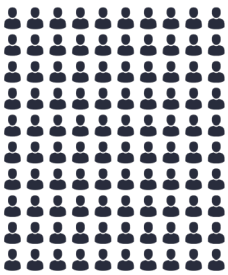

WHO DRAWS THE DISTRICTS?

STATE LEGISLATURE

HOW ARE DISTRICTS DRAWN?

Process

- State Legislature draws the lines
- Governor can veto the plan
- State Supreme Court may review the plan if an elector petitions

State-Level Criteria

Ranked: No

- Contiguity
- Compactness
- Follow political boundaries
- Preserve existing Senate districts

Public Hearings

- No redistricting-specific provisions

Timing

- Final plan must be enacted by Nov. 1 of years ending in 1
- If Legislature fails to pass a plan by the deadline, the state Supreme Court draws the lines
