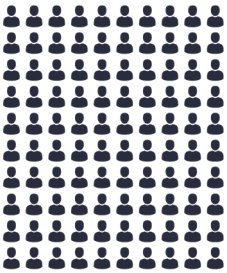

WHO DRAWS THE DISTRICTS?

POLITICIAN COMMISSION

- Three members: governor, secretary of state, attorney general

HOW ARE DISTRICTS DRAWN?

Process

- Politician commission draws the lines
- Governor can't veto the plan
- State Supreme Court will review or revise the plan if a citizen petitions

State-Level Criteria

Ranked: No

- Contiguity for Senate
- Follow county boundaries when practicable for Senate
- No specific criteria for House districts

Public Hearings

- No redistricting-specific requirements

Timing

- By Feb. 1 following each census
- Districts become effective 30 days from the filing date, unless proceedings for revision are initiated in the Supreme Court
