Process

- State Legislature draws the lines
- Governor can veto the plan
- Court challenges to legislative redistricting must be brought in Franklin Circuit Court

State-Level Criteria Ranked: No

- Follow county boundaries
- Contiguity
- No more than two counties to form a house district

Public Hearings No redistricting specific provisions

Timing

• No deadline but must be done every 10 years

• Same as for state legislative districts
